The next morning, Ralph and his several comrades try to light a fire in the cold air, but the attempt is hopeless without Piggy's glasses. The piglet, squinting and could barely see, invites Ralph to hold a meeting to discuss his options. Ralph blows up the sink, and the boys who don't go join Jack's tribe gather on the beach. They decide that their only choice - to go to Castle Rock, so that Jack and his followers see the reason. Ralph decides to take the sink to Castle Rock, hoping that she will remind Jack's followers of his former power. Once in Jack's camp, however, Ralph's group encounters armed guards. Ralph blows up the sink, but the guards tell them to leave and throw stones at them, trying to skip. Suddenly, Jack and a group of hunters come out of the forest, dragging a dead pig. Jack and Ralph immediately come face to face. Jack orders Ralph to leave his camp, and Ralph demands that Jack return piggy points. Jack attacks Ralph, and they fight. Ralph struggles to make Jack understand the importance of signal fire to any hope that the boys may have ever been rescued, but Jack orders his hunters to capture Sam and Eric and tie them up. This infuriates Ralph, and he lunges at Jack. Ralph and Jack fight for the second time. Piggy screams shrill, struggling to make himself heard for the brawl. While Piggy tries to talk, hoping to remind the group of the importance of rules and salvation, Roger pushes a massive rock down the mountainside. Ralph, who hears a rock fall, dives and dodges it. But the boulder strikes Piggy, destroys the sink he holds, and knocks him down the mountainside to death on the rocks below. Jack throws a spear at Ralph, while the other boys quickly join. Ralph escapes into the jungle, and Roger and Jack begin to torture Sam and Eric, forcing them to obey the power of Jack and join his tribe. Analysis In the chaos that ensues when the camps of Ralph and Jack enter into direct conflict, the two important characters in the novel - Shell and Lord of the Flies - are destroyed. Roger, the character least able to understand civilized impulse, crushes the shell when he loses a boulder and kills Piggy, the character least able to understand the wild impulse. As we see in the next chapter, Ralph, the boy most closely associated with civilization and order, destroys the Lord of the Flies, who controls the totem of dark impulses within each person. After the death of Piggy and the forced conversion of Sam and Eric to the tribe of Jack Ralph was left alone on the island, doomed to defeat by the forces of bloodshed and primitive Ralph's defeat takes place in the form of a hunt that has been closely linked to the wild instinct throughout the Lord of the Flies. Ironically, though hunting is necessary for the survival group - there is little other food on the island other than fruit that has made many of the boys sick - it's also what makes them into deadly barbarism. From the beginning of the novel, the hunters were the ones who pioneered the path to the realm of savagery and violence. In addition, the conflict between Ralph and Jack often manifested itself as a conflict between the interests of hunters and the interests of the rest of the group. In Chapter 3, for example, the boys argue about whether Jack's followers should be allowed to hunt or forced to build huts with Ralph and Simon. Now that Jack and the forces of savagery have risen to undeniable prominence on the island, hunting has completely conquered a more peaceful civilized instinct. Instead of successfully softening the power of hunting with the rules and structures of civilization, Ralph becomes a victim of the wild forces hunting represents- he has literally become prey.
